“Happy Holidays!”

November-December

A seasonal greeting that encompasses end-of-year cultural holidays and New Year's Eve.



“Happy Bodhi Day!”

December 8

A Buddhist holiday commemorating when Buddha attained enlightenment, usually observed with meditation, decorations, tea and cookies.



“Happy Yule/Solstice!”

December 21 - January 1

A pagan and Wiccan holiday celebrating the winter solstice with themes of light, fire and feasts.



“Merry Christmas!”

December 25

A prominent Christian holiday marking the birth of Jesus Christ in religious families, or celebrating giving and good will in secular families.



“Happy Boxing Day/ St. Stephen's Day!”

December 26

A holiday of Christian origin observed in British Commonwealth countries in which gifts are exchanged after Christmas or donated to the needy.



“Happy Kwanzaa!”

December 26 - January 1

An annual celebration of African American culture that includes food, songs, dancing, storytelling and more.



“Happy Diwali/ Diwali ki shubhkamnayein!”

Depending on Hindu calendar, falls between mid-September and mid-November

A Hindu, Sikh and Jain festival of lights and color with flowers, lamps and more to bring good fortune from gods and goddesses.



“Happy Hanukkah/ Chag Chanuka Sameach!”

Depending on Hebrew calendar, falls between late November and late December

An 8-day celebration in the Jewish faith celebrating the ancestral victory of the Maccabees in which families light a Menorah, exchange gifts and play dreidel games.
