The State of Substance Use & Prevention

About half of people who experience a mental illness will also experience a substance use disorder, and vice versa. **~17%** Americans aged 12 and older have battled an SUD, and **~11%** of Americans aged 12 and older had an alcohol use disorder (AUD) **in the past year.**
